Tea Light

Project Two

Materials
Glass tea light
Glass tiles – Mini Metallic – 25 of each colour: Pineweave, Copper, Hot Molten
- Shimmer Irregular Cut – 30 Citrine
Silicone Adhesive – Fix It Fast
Ice Block Stick
Sandpaper
Grey grout

- 1. Sand the tea light for better adhesion.
- 2. Group your tiles into colour groups.



3. Squeeze out a small amount of silicone adhesive into a container.

Don't squeeze out too much because it will dry out before you can use it.



4. Using the ice block stick spread some silicone onto the glass and begin sticking your tiles onto it.

Leave a small gap between the tiles for the grout.



Be sure to use enough glue so that the tiles can be pressed into it but not too much so that it oozes up between the tiles.

5. Keep spreading glue and sticking your tiles until the entire glass is covered.

Leave the glue to dry for at least 5 hours before grouting.



6. Mix grout according to manufacturers instructions.

Spread the grout on to the tea light using a soft sponge.

Remove excess grout and leave for about 10 minutes. Once a haze begins to form clean off with a soft clean cloth.



In about one hour give a final buff with a soft clean cloth.

Voila – a beautiful tea light to light up your Christmas table.
